Paul's Portion

I read an article online recently by Karl Vaters titled “9 Things I Love to See When I Visit a Church; I don't need a Hollywood-level production, just a genuine, healthy expression of worship and fellowship.” I do not know this author or any thing about him, other than what he reveals in his article. In the article, before the actual list Mr. Vaters makes the following observation, “Over the years, I've compiled a list of things I love to see when I visit a church. A lot of it is common knowledge, like clean bathrooms and proper signage. And some things are bonus, like a nice cup of coffee or a kickin' worship team.” This statement should serve as a sign of the tone of his list which is as follows, “1. I want to be greeted, but not overwhelmed; 2. I want an experience I can't get at any other church; 3. I want to feel like something unexpected might happen; 4. If something unusual happens, I want it explained; 5. I want to be one of the oldest people in the room; 6. I want to worship with people who don't look like me; 7. I want the emphasis to be on Jesus; 8. I want to hear how your church is blessing others; 9. I want to leave challenged – and better than when I came in.” While reading the list I was happy to see that Jesus did make the list, although He comes in at number 7, meaning that there were 6 other points that Mr. Vaters felt were more important to have in a church. I also found it interesting that when Mr. Vaters did finally include Jesus he said that he wanted to see Jesus as the emphasis. The problem with his statement is that all of the other points that he mentions as things which he looks for in a church make him the emphasis of the church, not Jesus. I might mention that the “common knowledge” points that he mentions earlier have the same effect. One thing that I noticed that was missing from his list and his idea of common knowledge was strong scriptural or doctrinal teaching. However, based on another of his statements, “In recent years, I've worked with churches of virtually every denomination,” he is not too concerned with doctrine. The problem is that he is only reflecting the attitude of many worshippers, where focus is on the worshippers rather than the One worshiped. It would seem that not only are people having itching ears, 2 Timothy 4:3, but whole itching psyches.
