Paul's Portion

I just returned from a week of church camp where I had an experience in my cabin that I also had about ten years ago. I, and the entire cabin, was the victim of a practical joke. Sometime prior to our arrival some prankster concealed an alarm clock in the crawl space above our bunks. This alarm clock was set to go off at roughly 2:35 AM, every morning. There are a couple of differences between the experience I had this past week and my experience of ten years ago. Ten years ago it took about three nights to figure out from whence the alarm came. This year I did not hear the alarm the first night, but my fellow counselor did, it took me a couple of nights to hear it. Also, ten years ago the rafters were all open, and once I determined that was where the alarm was coming from I merely climbed up into the rafters, and removed said alarm. The cabins now have ceilings, thus we were unable to get up in the rafters to remove the alarm. I do not know how the prankster put it there in the first place. An alarm is designed to wake people up. Usually you know for what time you set the alarm and thus are expecting to be wakened. I am assuming that the thought of the prankster was to wake people up when they were not expecting to wake up. Though it is not an alarm clock the Bible speaks of a time for people to wake up, and it also will be an unexpected time. In Matthew 24:36 Jesus says, “But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only.” He of course, is speaking of the day of judgment. This will be a rude awakening for many people, such as the hidden alarm was for me. As with the second hidden alarm clock there is nothing which we can do about the wake up call of which Jesus speaks. We can't remove the alarm or set it to a new time. We do see in 1 Thessalonians 5:4, however, that we do not have to be surprised by it. By the end of the week I was no longer surprised by the alarm going off at 2:35, I was ready for it. Like-wise we can be ready for that great wake-up call as well. John tells us that we are to be so ready for the day that we approach it with confidence, 1 John 4:17. We may not know when the alarm will go off, but we can be ready. Will you be surprised or ready when the final wake-up call comes?
