Paul's Portion

It is that time of year again, the time when people will go somewhere to be scared. There are even a host of options which allow you to be scared right in the living room. To get a good scare at home one can; read a scary book, watch a scary movie or television show, listen to scary music or old time radio show, or even go to scary websites, and again, there are probably a host of other options. In order to achieve the complete scare experience, one can even dress up in a scary costume while engaging in one of the above scary activities. Of course this all revolves around the holiday of Halloween, which has its history in the occult and demonic beliefs. With this history it is no surprise that the majority of the scary elements associated with this time of year have a demonic or monster connection. There are two questions that come to mind when considering this past-time. The first, and perhaps most obvious question, is why? Why is it that people enjoy being scared?
