Paul's Portion

Yesterday morning there was a large crowd gathered around a small two story building. They proceeded to move out across town covering blocks of sidewalk as they walked. The crowd marched around the town following a predetermined path until eventually arriving back at the starting point. As the crowd moved through the town they were not shouting rhetoric, slogans, mantras, or angry messages. The crowd was not composed of rioters, or militants. The crowd was composed of men, women, boys, girls, and a few canines. It is also of importance to note that the crowd was not composed of just one belief group. Although it is not known by this writer if there were any Jews, Muslims, Hindus, or other non-Christian faiths represented in the group, it is known that there were various Christian beliefs represented. Of these various groups there exists an array of doctrinal beliefs on such issues as; the Trinity, necessity of baptism for salvation, predestination, perseverance of the saints, etc. Despite these differences in doctrine these groups do all share the belief in God, and His Son, Jesus the Christ. These groups also share at least one other belief in common, the belief that caused them all to gather on this particular morning; they all believe in the sanctity of life. They all believe that it is wrong to take the life of an innocent child in the womb, or any innocent life at any time for that matter. They hold to the words of Solomon, which he wrote in Proverbs 6:17, the Lord hates those who shed the blood of innocents. Having this shared belief these have banded together in solidarity as a visual statement in opposition to the taking of life. The very fact that these groups have differing doctrinal beliefs, however, causes some to abstain from such activities. One has to wonder if this feeling carries over to other areas of life. If their house was burning down would they insist that all of the firefighters share the same beliefs? There is something to be said for the idea of not being "unequally yoked," (2 Corinthians 6:14), but there is also the idea of "two are better than one," (Ecclesiastes 4:9). If people do not work together on the issues on which they agree, how can they come to an agreement on the issues on which they disagree? In the meantime a lot of good can get accomplished.
