Paul's Portion

About a week ago we were all sitting in the living room when all of the sudden Ruby, our dog, jumped up to the window and began to bark forcefully and incessantly. This is not unusual behavior for Ruby. She has a tendency to bark at anything that goes down the street, joggers, walkers, bikes, other dogs, etc. She thinks that the street in front of our house is her domain and no one nor no thing else is permitted. On this occasion I looked out the window to see which neighbor had dared to intrude Ruby's territory. I looked out the window, glanced up and down the street and saw nothing. No matter how many times I told Ruby that there was nothing out there she continued to bark. Ruby headed to the door intent on enforcing her territory. Opening the door to let Ruby out, and prove to her that there was in fact nothing out there I saw the reason for her barking. Across the road and an empty lot, and past a stand of trees, just barely in sight there were three deer. Moments earlier I would have sworn that there was absolutely nothing outside to be seen, let alone meriting forceful barking. Now my eyes were opened to the "threat." Ruby easily detected what I could not see or sense. This is the way of the world. There are things of this world which lie unseen to many people. It is not that they are not looking, or that the things are not able to be seen. It is rather a matter of perception. At first I did not see the deer because I was limiting my sight to right in front of the house. Then I did not see the deer because they were partially concealed by the trees. It was not until I intently looked, because of Ruby's insistence that something was there, that I saw the deer. This is the way it is with many people and the truth of the Gospel. They fail to see what is there to be seen. Jesus reprimanded the disciples at one point saying, "Having eyes do you not see," Mark 8:18, for they failed to see the truth of His statement. Jesus also said of the crowds, "seeing they do not see," Matthew 13:13. Just as Jesus proclaimed to the people that they should open their eyes and see the truth that being taught the Bible still calls out for people to open their eyes and see the truth. Yet, the whole truth can't be seen by a casual glance. One must look intently and with purpose to discover all of the truth that lies in the Bible's pages.
