Paul's Portion

Today is Easter, it also April 1st, there is no way that I can let that pass without comment. Just to clarify for any who may not know, April 1st is also known as "April Fools Day," it is a day for jokes, pranks, and making fun of people. The tradition came about years ago when they changed the calendar making January 1st the first day of the New Year. There were those who were slow to catch on to the change, this made them April fools, and the victim of jokes. Since those early days it is open season for anyone to become a target for an April fool joke. Without even going to Psalm 14:1 and 53:1, "The fool has said in his heart there is no God," it is possible to comment on Easter falling on April 1st. We can make a connection between those who failed to see the change of the calendar and those who fail to see the change of Jesus from death to life. One can understand the reluctance to adopt a change in the calendar. If you had lived all of your life with the New Year beginning at the start of April and then suddenly you have to adjust to it being at the start of January it can be confusing and hard. Imagine that all of your life you have understood life and death to be nonnegotiable then suddenly you are told that death is not finite, but that there could be life after death, and that one had actually risen from death. You would probably find it confusing and hard to adjust. It is true that there had been others who had come back from the dead, the widow's son (Luke 7), Jairus' daughter (Mark 5), and Lazarus (John 11) to name a few. Still unless you had seen the resurrection with your own eyes you would tend to think that the stories of the dead coming to life are just that, stories. So, can we really call someone who doubts the resurrection a fool (Bearing in mind Jesus warning in Matthew 5:22)? It is probably a better idea for us to think of the doubters as misinformed and confused than to think of them as fools. Having said all of that it is necessary to understand that it is not good to leave people in a state of confusion as to the resurrection of Jesus Christ. For as it may not be that someone is a fool for doubting, it is foolish to remain doubtful. Jesus did rise up from his cold tomb to conquer death for all of mankind. To reject Jesus' accomplishment and His gift of eternal life is the very definition of acting foolishly, so be wise.
