## Paul's Portion

Little Johnny is a typical 8 year old boy, he enjoys playing hard and getting dirty. Most days Johnny comes in the house at the end of a long day of playing covered in dirt from head to toe. Being a good mother, Johnny's mother does not let Johnny stay covered in dirt. She requires that Johnny remove the dirt before he has his dinner. Johnny, being a good boy, wants to please his mother, so he makes attempts at being clean. First Johnny acknowledges that he is dirty and wants to be clean, but when he tries to sit at the table his mother stops him stating that he still needs to get clean. Next Johnny remembers that his mother used to give him baths, so he confesses his mother's power to make him clean. Again, however, his mother stops him; telling him that he still needs to have his dirt removed. Getting desperate, and hungry, Johnny goes to the sink and washes his right hand, (Because that's the hand he uses to eat). Fully convinced that he has fulfilled his mother's wish he heads to the table. Johnny is dismayed when he hears his mother say, "Nice try, but you have to remove all of the dirt". Finally, Johnny takes a bath, and removes all the dirt from his body. When Johnny heads to the table this time his mother gladly sits him down and feeds him his dinner. According to Isaiah 59:2 our sins separate us from God, and Romans 6:23 states that our sins lead to death. Many people attempt to take care of their sin problem the way that Johnny attempted to take care of his dirt problem. There are some people who think that their sin problem is fixed by simply acknowledging that they have unwanted sin. Others go a step further and confess the power of Jesus to take away their sins (Often quoting Romans 10:9-10). Finally, there are those who will sprinkle a little water on themselves convinced that this will remove their sins. All of these people, just like Johnny, are sincere in their desire to be clean. They are also all sincere in their attempts to be clean. However, also just like Johnny, they will not be clean until they take the action that washes them clean. Luckily, the Bible outlines that action. In Acts 22:16 Ananias tells Saul to "Rise and be baptized and wash away your sins". It is not until we are baptized, which is total immersion, that our sins are removed, and we are able to stand unstained before God. Have you been washed clean?
