## Paul's Portion

There once was a small town which had only two doctors to serve the citizens. For the sake of this article we will refer to them simply as doctor A and doctor B. Both of the doctors were graduates of prestigious medical schools, and both graduated near the top of their respective classes. Both doctors were male, they were roughly the same age, and with the same basic body shape. Even though their practices were on opposite sides of town, both doctor A and doctor B had very similar offices with basically the same equipment. They even had the same reading material in their waiting area. Yet despite all of the similarities between these two doctors, doctor B had a much larger patient clientele than doctor A. It seems that doctor B had a fantastic bedside manner, with a jovial and charismatic personality. The adults liked to go to doctor B because he would joke around with them. Doctor B was very upbeat and caused you to leave his office with a good feeling. The children liked to go to doctor B because he would give them little treats and do magic tricks. On the other side of town doctor A was a more serious physician. Doctor A had an average bedside manner, he was a pleasant enough man, but he was not very charismatic. When you went to doctor A he would focus on how you were feeling and how to get you feeling better if you were not well. There were two other differences between doctor B and doctor A. Doctor A adhered to strict proven medical procedures. Doctor B relied more on how he felt he should treat a person, and was quick to try the latest medical fads. The other difference between the two doctors is that doctor A had a much higher success rate in curing his patients than doctor B. Yet, despite this people still preferred to go to doctor B, because he was so charismatic. Ridiculous you say, no one would choose charisma over healing you say. People do it all of the time, but instead of doctor put preacher and instead of doctor office put place of worship. Churches are full every Sunday with people who are leaving feeling good, because they have had an enjoyable experience, yet they have not had any spiritual healing. Paul was so correct when he wrote to Timothy about itching ears, 2 Timothy 4:3. People are having their ears scratched, and it feels good, but it does nothing for the soul.
