Paul's Portion

Our family has a cat which my daughter named Jaguar Panther Midnight Carpenter. We call him Jag for short. Jag has always been an inside cat, from the day that we adopted him from the litter of kittens which a stray cat had in our bushes. We take care of all of Jag's needs, food, water, shelter, and when he deems us worthy, love and affection. This cat lacks nothing for a good, safe and long life. However, providing Jag with all that he needs to live does not stop Jag from constantly wanting to go outside. I couldn't begin to count the number of times that Jag has attempted to slip out a door while someone was going in or out, or basically any time that a door is opened. I also couldn't begin to count how many times Jag has been successful at slipping out a door. It doesn't have to be a door either. There was one time that he managed to escape into the great outdoors by pushing open a window screen. Every time that Jag gets out my daughter goes onto a panic. She is concerned that Jag will not be able to survive outside, away from our care (There are coyotes around). The question is, why does Jag constantly attempt to get outside when he has all the comforts of life available to him inside. I guess the simple answer is, because of the innate call of the wild. The lure of the outside world is too great to resist. Thus, he is willing to lose all that he has for a chance at being in the wild. This describes many people's spiritual life so well. Jesus says that He is the "Way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6), and that if we need the things for life that they will be provided if we seek Him first, (Matthew 6:33) and also that in Him we can have life abundantly (John 10:10). This is to say that in Jesus we can basically have the "Life of Riley," no worries or concerns, just relax and let Jesus care for us, (1 Peter 5:7). Yet, so many times as we sit enjoying the pleasures of life the Lord provides the world entices us, luring us out of our safety for a chance at experiencing a moment of life in the wild. Thus far, Jag has survived his excursions into the wild, despite the dangers, which has bolstered his desire to escape to the wild. Likewise, each time that we venture into the world of sin and make it back we are more convinced that we can survive sins dangers. Just remember the lion is waiting to pounce (1 Peter 5:8).
