Today’s Bible Passage

⁴⁷Praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Paul’s Portion

Just finished another week of church camp; every year it is the same, as far as the young people who attend camp. There are the young people who attend camp, because they love camp, every aspect of camp. There are those who attend, because they love the Spiritual aspect of camp. Judging from what Paul says about Timothy in 2 Timothy 3:14-15, (¹⁴But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it ¹⁵and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus), Timothy would have fit in this group. There are those who attend camp, because they love the social aspect of being at camp. Unfortunately, often these turn into situations like what Paul faced with Peter in Galatians 2:11-14, Peter was ignoring some brethren (Gentiles) to hang out with other brethren (Jews). There are those who attend, because they don’t have anything else to do. The parents in this instance may have been thinking about Proverbs 22:6, (⁶Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it), hoping that church camp would give their children direction in life. There are those who attend, because, thinking about Deuteronomy 6:7, (⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise), their parents hope that church camp will straighten the child out. There are also those who attend church camp, because they are forced to attend, but they don’t want to be there. Perhaps the parents of these young people were thinking about Proverbs 13:24, (²⁴Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him), and practicing a little tough love. No matter what the reason for the child attending church camp, then it should be a positive experience for the child. Parents just need to be careful and follow the advice of 1 John 4:1 and guarantee that the church camp is in alignment with the Lord’s teaching and His will for their little one. Church camp, besides providing the child with great experiences can also provide the parents with some much needed rest, a foreshadow of Hebrews 4:9.
