Paul's Portion

“You can't get a man with a gun,” is a line from one of the songs in the musical “Annie Get Your Gun.” It goes along with the saying, “You can catch more flies with honey than vinegar,” (To which someone has quipped, “Who wants flies?”). Both of these statements are expressing the idea of the best way to get results. There is also the expression of, “The right tool for the right job.” You don't use a sledgehammer to push a thumb tack into a bulletin board, nor do you use a whisk broom to clean up Times Square after the New Year's Ball drop. Basically, to get the results that you want you have to go about getting those results in the proper manner or method. The same holds true when attempting to achieve Spiritual results. If you want to have a better understanding of the Bible you don't achieve that by reading what other people have written about the Bible, you achieve it by reading the Bible for yourself (Acts 17:11). If you want to have a better prayer life you don't achieve that by thinking about praying, you achieve it by being in prayer more often (1 Thessalonians 5:17). If you want to feel a closer relationship with the Lord you don't achieve that by immersing yourself in things of the world, you achieve that by immersing yourself in things of the Lord (Colossians 3:2). If you want to bring more people to Christ you don't achieve that by resorting to gimmicks, or tricks, or bait and switch tactics, you achieve that by following Paul's advice to Timothy found in 1 Timothy 4:11-16; “¹¹Command and teach these things. ¹²Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity. ¹³Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching. ¹⁴Do not neglect the gift you have, which was given you by prophecy when the council of elders laid their hands on you. ¹⁵Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress. ¹⁶Keep a close watch on yourself and on the teaching. Persist in this, for by so doing you will save both yourself and your hearers.” Notice the focus is first getting stronger as a Christian yourself. Christians can achieve the spiritual results they seek, but it does not come from the world's methods, it comes from following the Lord and His inspired word.
