Paul's Portion

A couple of days ago as I was driving down the highway I noticed that a new cell tower is being erected a few miles from my home. For some people, and in some parts of the country, the idea of a new cell tower being constructed would not cause much excitement. Around my home, and for myself, however, new cell towers are exciting times. The simple reason for the excitement being that my cell phone coverage is spotty at best. There are numerous places where I am unable to get any signal at all, and even more places where the signal is very weak. Thus, whenever a new tower is erected I have the hope that it will be for the carrier that I utilize. When previous towers have gone up I have had the same excitement, only to have my hopes dashed with the news that the towers were for other carriers. Thinking about my excitement over cell tower construction made me wonder what other types of construction gets other people excited. I imagine there are those who are excited when they see stores, restaurants, and banks being constructed in hopes that it will be one of their favorites. Perhaps some are excited about the construction of homes, because they enjoy the prospect of new neighbors. I wonder if there are any people who get excited over the construction of a place of worship. When you are driving down the road, and before you see the sign saying “Future site of”, but you can tell it is going to be a place of worship, are you excited hoping that it will be another place of true (John 4:24) worship? Then when you get close enough to the sign stating that it will be another place of false worship are you awash with disappointment? While most people do not have much control over the construction of new cell towers, stores, banks, or restaurants; Christians do have control over whether new places of worship need to be constructed and are being constructed. This is accomplished when Christians follow Jesus' instruction of Matthew 28:19-20, and make disciples in all nations. The more true disciples there are, those who believe and obey the whole will of God (Matthew 7:21), the more places of worship that will be needed. Christians should dream of and work toward the day when there are as many places of true worship to the Lord being constructed as there are stores, restaurants, and banks.
