Paul's Portion

Probably at some time in their life everyone has believed a lie. What makes us believe lies? To help answer this question three lies will be examined. In any discussion about lies it is probably natural to begin with the first lie. That first lie of course is the lie that the serpent told Eve, Genesis 3:4-5. The lie itself being that God had lied, and that Adam and Eve would surely not die if they ate the forbidden fruit. So, why was this lie believed? Quite simply, the lie was believed because the hearer wanted to believe it. Right after the lie verse six states that the woman desired the fruit to satisfy hunger, the eye, and the ego. In short she wanted the fruit which made it easy to believe the lie. Today there are many people who believe lies for the same reason, the lie is what they want to hear. Paul warned of this when he spoke of itching ears, 2 Timothy 4:3. The second lie to be examined is the lie Joseph's brothers told Jacob, Genesis 37:31-32. Although we do not see them actually telling Jacob that Joseph had been killed by a wild animal we do see in verse 20 that this was the plan. So why did Jacob believe this lie? It can not be the same reason as was stated for lie number one, since Joseph being killed was about the furthest thing possible from Jacob's desire. Jacob believed the lie because his sons presented him with "evidence". Yes, the evidence was fabricated, but Jacob did not know, nor did he investigate to see if the lie was true. This is another cause for many lies to be believed. Supposed evidence is presented which seems to back up the lie, and too often people do not investigate the evidence. The third lie involves Joseph as well; it is the lie Potiphar's wife told about Joseph attacking her, Genesis 39:11-18. This again is a lie that is not believed because it filled a desire, nor was evidence really the reason. This lie was believed because it was told by a trusted loved one. Here is perhaps the biggest reason for a lie to be believed. We want to believe our loved ones and not accept that they would lie to us. Yet, lies do occur between family members, and between friends. The answer is not to never trust any one, but it is wise to be sure of facts before believing what you are told, no matter who it is telling you the facts. This is especially true regarding Spiritual and salvation issues. Are you sure that what you have been taught is the truth, even if it was taught by your parents?
