Today’s Bible Passage

Paul’s Portion

Many, many, many thousands of years ago the Lord created the Earth. After He had made the world just as He wanted the Lord placed man and woman on the Earth and said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it,” Genesis 1:28. Man listened to the Lord and they were fruitful and they did multiply upon the face of the Earth. Unfortunately, as they multiplied in population they also multiplied in sin and reproach. Mankind’s sin became so great that the Lord had to do something about it, so He sent the flood and destroyed all of mankind, except Noah and his family. After God recreated, in a sense, the Earth, and Noah and his family came out of the ark God said to them, “And you, be fruitful and multiply, increase greatly on the earth and multiply in it” Genesis 9:7. It would seem that in the Old Testament God’s plan was to fill the Earth with His people. In the story of Onan and Tamar we see just how serious God was about His people populating the Earth. Judah got Tamar as wife for his firstborn son, Er, but Er was wicked and the Lord put him to death. As was the custom back then, Judah sent Onan, his second born son, unto Tamar to produce offspring for Er. We then read in Genesis 38:9, “But Onan knew that the offspring would not be his. So whenever he went in to his brother’s wife he would waste the semen on the ground, so as not to give offspring to his brother.” This action obviously went against God’s plan of being fruitful and multiplying, this is brought out in verse 10, “And what he did was wicked in the sight of the Lord, and He put him to death also.” God’s desire was that the whole Earth be filled with His people, and He was not happy when His people did not take proper action to fulfill this desire. In a very like manner it is now God’s desire that His people fill the world with believers. The difference is that, He expects His people to spread over the Earth not with procreation but with proclamation. We see this in the “Great Commission” where Jesus tells the disciples to “Make disciples of all nations,” Matthew 28:19. It is also evidenced in the scattering of the believers throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, Acts 8:1. God still wants His people to be fruitful and multiply. It still makes Him unhappy to see His people not living up to this task, or worse wasting the seed on the ground. Are we being fruitful and multiplying?
