### Today’s Bible Passage

John 19:17, English Standard Version.

<sup>17</sup>and He went out, bearing His own cross, to the place called The Place of a Skull, which in Aramaic is called Golgotha.

### Paul’s Portion

In the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead there is a powerful statement at the beginning of the narrative. As Jesus is explaining to His disciples the reason that He needs to return to Judea He states, “Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I go to awaken him.” (John 11:11) When the disciples hear this they are confused thinking Jesus means that Lazarus is simply resting. Jesus explains that Lazarus had indeed died. It is interesting to note that the disciples do not question Jesus about how He knew that Lazarus was asleep. The message Jesus received was that Lazarus was ill, not that he was asleep or had died. Still, two days later Jesus knows that Lazarus had died. If Jesus, while He was on this earth, could know what was happening with someone who was in a different village, then surely while Jesus is in heaven He can know what is happening in our lives. Knowing what is happening Jesus can then, just as He did with Lazarus, take the proper steps to take care of us. We need to remember, however, that part of Jesus taking care of us may include allowing things to get worse, just as He did with Lazarus. The encouraging thing is that Jesus is able to handle things. When Jesus decided that it was the right time to go to Lazarus notice that He said “I go to awaken Him.” Jesus did not say, “I go to see what I might be able to do.” Nor, “I go to attempt to awaken him.” Jesus not only knew what was happening with Lazarus, but He also knew that He was able to handle the situation. There may be times in our lives when we wonder if Jesus really knows the trials which we are going through. If this were not enough, our wonderings are then compounded with the question of whether or not Jesus is able to handle our situation. Part of this stems from our tendency to feel that our situation is unique. We forget that, there is nothing new under the sun, (Ecclesiastes 1:9) The real reason for our shaky faith in Jesus’ abilities concerning our situation is not because of Jesus’ lack of understanding of what is happening in our lives, but our own confusion. Just as the disciples did not understand what was really happening with Lazarus, we often do not really understand what is happening with us. Thus, we need to remember when we are going through things that, just as with Lazarus, it is ultimately for God’s glory.
