The Seven Greatest things on Earth:

1. The Soul is the greatest thing in the world. Man's immortal spirit is the gift of God (Ecclesiastes 12:7; Acts 17:28; Hebrews 12:9); it is eternal (Revelation 6:9; Matthew 10:28). What would you give for it? (Matthew 16:26). Christ died for it, showing it is worth more than all the world (James 1:21; 5:20).

2. Sin is the greatest evil in the world. All sin is evil and all evil is sin. It separates us from God (Isaiah 59:1-2; Genesis 3:1). It is the source of all suffering, misery, pain, and death. Be sure your sin will find you out (Numbers 32:23).
