Paul's Portion

There is an interesting story found in 2 Samuel 23:13-17: ¹³And three of the thirty chief men went down and came about harvest time to David at the cave of Adullam, when a band of Philistines was encamped in the Valley of Rephaim. ¹⁴David was then in the stronghold, and the garrison of the Philistines was then at Bethlehem. ¹⁵And David said longingly, "Oh, that someone would give me water to drink from the well of Bethlehem that is by the gate!" ¹⁶Then the three mighty men broke through the camp of the Philistines and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem that was by the gate and carried and brought it to David. But he would not drink of it. He poured it out to the Lord ¹⁷and said, "Far be it from me, O Lord, that I should do this. Shall I drink the blood of the men who went at the risk of their lives?" Therefore he would not drink it. David simply expressed a desire to have a drink from the well of Bethlehem and these men rushed to meet his desire. They went to the heart of the enemy forces at the risk of life and limb. (I wish that there were more detail given, such as if they actually encountered enemy forces.) Why would these men perform such an act over a cup of water? It was not the water that compelled them, but the desire to serve their King whom they loved. At receiving the water David, realizing the cost of the water, poured it out to the Lord rather than drink it. David saw it not as a cup of water, but as a cup of the blood of these men, and he did not feel worthy of such a drink. In John chapter four, while talking with the woman of Samaria Jesus talks about the water of eternal life. This water is a representation of blood. It is not of the blood of three mighty men, but the blood of one mighty man. A mighty man who entered the enemy camp, encountered the enemy and through His death conquered the enemy. In His death Jesus became the spring of living water. Now the water is made available to forever quench one's thirst. There are those who are longing for a drink of this water. The question is; who will take the water to the thirsty? Are there mighty men and women in the Lord's army who will go forth into the world braving the encounters with the enemy to bring water to those who are longing for a drink? Like David we are not worthy of such a drink, but also like David, by taking it and pouring it on our sins we are pouring it out to God.
