Paul's Portion

The present crisis with the coronavirus, or "Covid-19" has brought out some interesting views among the populace. In an effort to slow down and lesson the spread of the virus in America, the President, and most, if not all, state governors have issued strict directives for the citizens to follow. These directives include the order to "Shelter in place," that is to stay home and only venture out for essentials. The directives also included the shutting down of large portions of commerce and really businesses in general. As the shut down drags on many citizens are questioning the validity of these drastic measures, and are calling for a re-opening of America. The argument is that the politicians are overreacting. Those who are advocating for a relaxing of the directives state that we are not seeing the severity of cases that were forecast. All of this is reminiscent of a couple of stories from the Old Testament. The first is found in Genesis chapter 6. Most assuredly the people thought that Noah's warning about the flood was him overreacting. After all it wasn't raining when Noah began building the Ark. The other story is Found in Genesis chapter 41. For seven years Joseph rationed the food grown in Egypt. He stored up so much food that the Scriptures say they stoped counting it, because it was too much to count, Genesis 41:49. As the people had to give up large portions of their crop for a famine that could not yet be seen it is not hard to imagine that more than a few of them questioned the validity of its severity. When the times came Noah floated above all of the skeptics, and Egypt had plenty of food during the famine years. In like manner there are many today who feel that Christians are overreacting when they warn about the end of the world and the wrath of the Lord to come. They can't believe that it will be as bad as they have been told. Therefore, they do not prepare for the end that is coming. Rest assured Christians are not overreacting when they warn to prepare for the Lord's return. Though it may seem that the day of the Lord's return is never going to occur, or at least not in "My lifetime," one needs to remember that this has been the attitude since the time of Peter's writing, 2 Peter 3:4. Do not allow yourself to be deceived by the apparent normalcy of the world, neither with Covid-19 nor the coming of the Lord. Rather, with wisdom prepare for both.
