Paul's Portion

Everyone is familiar with the concept of "Love at first sight," how many, however, are familiar with the concept of "Loath at first sight." Though one may not be familiar with the language, more than likely the feeling is familiar. Despite old adages such as, "You can't tell a book by its cover," and "Beauty is only skin deep," people still tend to make judgment calls about others before really getting to know them. This is often compounded by past experiences. If the past experience was traumatic enough it may very well cause one to experience a sense of loathing at the mere sight of anyone who may resemble or elicit memories of the event. For instance, if a person was once terrified by a biker gang, that person has an aversion to anyone who may have the appearance of a "Biker." Or perhaps one's heart was broken which causes bitter feelings toward that type. Then there is also the real problem of inbred loathing at first sight. Sometimes this is intentional, but often unintentional as well. Many times parents are actually the ones who are guilty of this. In an effort to protect children parents tell them to beware of certain types. Naturally, children do need to be protected by predators. Unfortunately, predators rarely wear signs announcing that they are dangerous predators. Thus, parents are forced to use descriptions to warn their children. Therefore, this can instill in children a loathing at first sight for those who fit the descriptions. The problem is that a person looking like a pedophile does not make that person a pedophile. Others have been conditioned to "Loath at first sight" by the media and public opinion. All of this makes it difficult to live up to the standard God sets in 1 Samuel 16:17, "For the Lord sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart." Until we can truly learn to see as God sees there will be a problem with people experiencing "Loath at first sight." Strive, therefore, to go beyond conditioning of loathing to a state of "Love at first sight."
