Paul's Portion

How often do we experience truly blind faith? Christians will often quote Paul's words of, "We walk by faith, not by sight," 2 Corinthians 5:7. Yet, how often do Christians really take the leap of faith? It is one thing to walk by faith in the sense of trusting that God will provide the means to put supper on the table. It is quite another thing to walk by faith as evidenced by the numerous Biblical characters. One can look at the three Hebrew children, Daniel 3. Strength of faith was seen in their response to Nebuchadnezzar, that whether God delivered them or not, they would not bow down. The true example of their walk by faith and not by sight is seen in what transpired next. They went into that fiery furnace not knowing what would happen. Scripture is silent about when the "Fourth" appeared in the fire, but one can imagine that the three did not see him until after they were in the fire themselves. Yet, we have no record of them doubting or hesitating in their walk of faith not sight. The same can be said of Daniel in the lions den, Daniel . Scripture is silent about when the angel came to shut the mouths of the lions. Daniel also did not stumble in his walk of faith. Imagine Daniel falling into the den and seeing the hungry lions looking at him and licking their chops, still he trusted in his Lord. If Daniel had relied on sight he would have despaired, but relying on faith he was able to enjoy a good night's rest. Mention could also be made of Noah who, many scholars believe, had never seen rain before, yet walking in faith not sight he built an ark preparing for a flooding rain, Genesis 6. Then there is David who in a walk of faith not sight went up against a giant with a sling, 1 Samuel 17. If David had walked by sight, as the rest of the Israelites, he would have trembled and run away. Walking by faith allowed him to strike down Goliath. What dear Christian will you be able to surmount in your walk of faith not sight? There are still giants to conquer, lions to tame, and fires to withstand. So, walk on.
